Better graphics & viewing options

- Completely new graphics engine featuring a more photorealistic look of both characters and Dojo, including real-time shadows, facial characteristics and more! (Original "classic-mannequin" look is still supported)
- Multi-resolution screen support up to Full HD viewing!
- Netbook support for lower resolution smaller screen computers. (*)
- Full screen, UI-free mode for uninterrupted video-like viewing.
- 3D Glasses support for an even more realistic visual experience.

- Automatic camera tracking always keeps Uke and Nage at optimal view.
